LAWRENCEVILLE, GA — Today, State Senator Zahra Karinshak (D-48), candidate for Congress in Georgia's 7th District, announced her campaign enters election year with more than \$420,000 cash on hand, less than five months after entering the race.

In recent weeks Karinshak has received endorsements from former Governor Roy Barnes, former U.S. Senator Max Cleland, VoteVets and Serve America PACS, and ten colleagues in the Georgia General Assembly.

"I'm honored that so many Georgians have put their trust in me to flip this seat blue," Karinshak said. ABOUT ZAHRA KARINSHAK

Zahra Karinshak, a veteran and former federal prosecutor, was elected to the State Senate in 2018. She won the seat, long held by Republicans, with 53.6% of the vote, and went on to be elected by her colleagues as Chairwoman of the Gwinnett Senate delegation. In addition to her service as a State Senator, Karinshak is a partner at the Atlanta law firm Krevolin & Horst where she leads the firm's whistleblower practice, working with clients to expose fraud and corruption at the highest levels.

Karinshak and her husband Bruce, a West Point graduate who served in the Army as a Combat Engineer, have lived for the past 25 years in Lawrenceville, GA where they've raised their two teenage daughters.
