ZAHRA KARINSHAK QUALIFIES FOR 7TH DISTRICT CONGRESSIONAL RACE

Atlanta, GA: State Senator Zahra Karinshak appeared at the State Capitol this morning and qualified as a candidate for the 7th Congressional District. Karinshak was joined by volunteers who have worked with her since her 2018 State Senate run, along with her oldest daughter, who first urged her to run for office nearly four years ago.

With the support of Vote Vets and Serve America, as well as former Governor Roy Barnes, former Senator Max Cleland, and ten sitting members of the Georgia General Assembly, Zahra is assembling a broad coalition of support that will ensure that she carries the 7th District.

Zahra will take her lifetime of experience as a veteran, prosecutor, state senator and mother, to fight in Washington for affordable healthcare, strong public schools, safe communities, environmental protection, and civil rights for all Americans.

Zahra Karinshak, a veteran and former federal prosecutor, was elected to the State Senate in 2018. She won the seat, long held by Republicans, with 53.6% of the vote, and went on to be elected by her colleagues as Chairwoman of the Gwinnett Senate delegation. In addition to her service as a State Senator, Karinshak is a partner at the Atlanta law firm Krevolin & Horst where she leads the firm's whistleblower practice, working with clients to expose fraud and corruption at the highest levels.

Karinshak and her husband Bruce, a West Point graduate who served in the Army as a Combat Engineer, have lived for the past 25 years in Lawrenceville, GA where they've raised their two teenage daughters.
